Tips and Tricks

"What do I need to do to get ready for the season?" is a question we frequently get asked here in the store. We recommend attending our Spring Startup Class, March 12th for starters. However, if you want to get a head start, remove the net if you put one on last fall and clean leaves and debris from around the pond. Using a dip net, clean out any debris you can reach; cut off any dead foliage, clean your filters, treat heavily with bacteria and remove any debris that has accumulated over the winter in your waterfall and stream.

New Products for 2011...Rainwater harvesting, patio misting systems and low voltage landscape lighting are all new products for us this year. Come visit the store to see these and other new products we've added to make your outdoor living experience even more enjoyable. As always, new fish, plants, fountains, statuary and pottery also arrive during the spring so there is lots to see around the store and display yard.
