But, we live in the wonderful state of Oklahoma which is known for "unpredictable" weather (no offense intended to our learned weathermen); so as a reminder for pond maintenance during the winter, I offer the following. Do not feed your fish (they cannot digest the food in cold temperatures); do not let the water surface of your pond freeze over entirely (an opening must exist for gases to escape) for the protection of your fish; remove all fallen debris that you are able to from your pond in order to reduce the amount of "sludge" in the Spring. Nets and "heaters" are available to assist you in your winter maintenance. Enjoy your winter and stay safe.

Tips and Tricks

Believe it or not using 2 pumps in your pond can cost you less in operating costs than using a single pump! Let me explain how this works.

You use a smaller pump that runs continuously to supply your pond filter 24/7, while using a second pump to power a waterfall or fountain. Your pond only needs to turn over once an hour. The pump supplying the waterfall or fountain can be switched off when you are at work or asleep either on a remote or a timer. In other words you can switch it on or off whenever you feel like it and not harm your fish or the health of the pond.
